INDIVIDUAL LESSONS

Individual lessons are an important element in any player's development. They give you a chance to focus more directly on particular issues, be they technical, theoretical or conceptual, and to develop practice routines to take your jazz playing forward.

This works at all levels - from jazz beginners wanting some basic information to get started, perhaps with a view to trying some group playing - right up to aspiring professionals preparing for auditions at the country's elite conservatoires.

Nick Weldon, one of the most experienced jazz teachers in the UK, offers individual lessons in jazz piano, double bass, and theory, and also coaches all instrumentalists, including singers, in performance, composition, improvisation, repertoire and artistic development.

Andra Sparks gives individual lessons in jazz singing and vocal technique.

Felix Weldon, currently endorsed by Liberty Drums and Bosphorus Cymbals, and an active player on both the contemporary rock and jazz scenes, is our drum teacher.

Dominic Ashworth, one of the most versatile and in-demand guitarists in the UK, teaches guitar.

Alex Merritt teaches saxophone, theory and transcription.

Lessons may be held at <u>Jazz School UK</u> or elsewhere according to the needs of the student, and may take place in person or if more convenient via Skype. Other tutors may also be available.

The cost of a course of lessons is: initial lesson £65 then blocks of 4 hours @ £200.
